Negotiated the 1989 agreement between ESA Purpan and KSU, and led the negotiation of two subsequent memoranda of understandings pursuant to that agreement. From 1990 to 2002, forty-six Purpan students studied at KSU as fourth year students in agribusiness or in other agriculture majors. A subsequent memorandum of understanding provides for fifth-year Purpan students to enroll in the M.S. program in Agricultural Economics at KSU. The second memorandum led to a summer program in France for KSU students consisting of a month-long short course at Purpan and a month's stay on a French farm. The students learn French language, culture and agriculture during the stay. Through 2002, twenty-eight KSU students have completed either that program or a one semester study at Purpan.

Project Director for North American Agribusiness Consortium, 1995-2000.

The North American Agribusiness Consortium is a multilateral clearing house for exchange of students among six institutions in the three NAFTA countries. I founded and administered the development of a six school multinational agreement for the exchange of students. The efforts of the cooperating schools were funded in part by grants from three governments. A grant from the Ministry of Higher Education in Mexico supported activities and exchanges at Universidad de Sonora and at the Instituto Technologico y de Estudios Superiores de Monterrey. A grant from the Department of Human Resources, Canada, supported activities and exchanges at University of Manitoba and at the University of Laval. The grant from the U.S. Department of Education, Foundation for Improvement of Post Secondary Education supported the activities and exchanges at Purdue University and at Kansas State University. The linked grants provided for multilateral student exchanges and the development of joint faculty efforts among the six schools in the areas of agribusiness, agricultural economics, milling, food science and food safety and provided the base for further exchange programs in these areas. Exchanges have continued to occur after the grants expired.
